



## BE A RECYCLING HERO

On 23 August 2023, a group of six FBF staff and two FBF students visited SJKC Chung Huah (pre-school) from 10.00 am to 12.30 pm to educate the children about the importance of recycling habits.



According to Malaysia Solid Waste Management Department (2022), Malaysians produce nearly 39,936 tonnes of daily wastes. Additionally, Malaysia's recycling rate in year 2021 was 31.52%, which is a lower as compared to the neighbouring counties like Singapore (59%) or Thailand (34%). Therefore, it is crucial to aggressively promote education and awareness recycling programme particularly among students, to cultivate recycling habit at young age.

This programme aims to educate the children (aged 5-6 years old) about the value of recycling which later encourages them to think about how their personal action affect the earth and future environment. With this program, learning about recycling helps students to develop recycling habit and develop them as conscientious adults to implement recycling tactics in daily activities which help to reduce waste.



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The committee had prepared 3 topics of recycle interactive learning to the children which include (1) How to protect our environment (2) Type of pollution and (3) Recycle facts: How much we can do? After the sharing of recycling topics, children are divided into 6 groups for recycling craft. The children required to color the recycling bins and sort the items into the correct bins.
